A maximum of 4 project animals may be listed on this form from which show animals must be selected.

Half or less of animals entered may be checked as Family/Household entries (ex: 1 of 2 or 3, 2 of 4).

The Show requires that the animal exhibited at the Show be the same animal enrolled at the validation/registration.

You must have attended an approved quality assurance program (if not our county program, must have a certificate on file with entry) as of June 1.

If you want a date-stamped copy of your entry form, you must provide your own copy. Copies will **NOT** be provided at the Fairgrounds, only stamped.
